

NOTICE OF PRIVACY

Legal basis. Ley Federal de Protección de Datos Personales en Posesión de los Particulares (DataProtection Act).

Personal data Protection Responsible: Grupo Industrial Durandco, S.A. of C.V. - including subsidiary and related companies - (hereinafter GID).

GID is a legally incorporated and existing company in accordance with the Mexican legislation.

GID is specialized in providing services to the offshore and oil & gas industry, including services related to different operational nature vessels through a wide range of technological solutions, such as ship-tanks, DPV (Dynamic Positioning Vessels), FSV (Fast Supply Vessels), PSV (Platform Supply Vessels), FPSO (Floating, Production, Storage and Offloading Vessels).

The portfolio of services is complemented by logistics, agency services and engineering services.

Personal data processing legal base: GID is responsible for the protection and treatment of personal data collected, in terms of Article 6 of the Data Protection Act and other applicable provisions.

Personal data protection: The Data Protection Act and its secondary regulation, have the object of protect the personal data held by corporations and individuals persons, in order to regulate its use, disclose, store, control, processing and guarantee the privacy and the right to informational self-determination of the people.

The data Owners may enter into previous contact or approach to GID, or access to its services or offer a service, for the foregoing, it is necessary that such owners voluntarily provide personal data, such as full name, age, date of birth, occupation, federal taxpayer record, employer, address, telephone number, email, or any other information necessary to follow up.

The collection of information and personal data made by GID is carried out through reliable and secure media for the protection of such information provided by the Owners, in terms of the provisions of the Data Protection Act.

Personal Data collection objectives

After your express consent, your personal data will be used for purposes related to:

- Follow-up, update and confirmation regarding the services requested and contracted between GID and the personal data owners;
- The promotion, contracting, financing and any matter related to the relationship between GD- personal data owner, regarding the services provided by GID;
- The management of commercial, labor, administrative matters, as well as for statistical purposes.

- The analysis, measurement, implementation and improving of GID processes and services;
- Trends and consumption preferences analysis.

Personal Data use, Handling and processing

The personal data received by GID from the owners who provide voluntarily, whether through physical, electronic or any other media, shall be treated and protected as private and confidential, in order to guarantee its privacy.

GID makes constant efforts to improve its procedures to protect the security of the personal data that the owners provide, in order to prevent access to any unauthorized third party.

The personal data collected by GID, directly and through electronic media, is:

- Name and surname,
- Gender;
- birthdate,
- phone, email
- address

In the sharing of personal data, owners are bound to provide it in a precise, clear, complete and updated manner.

Exceptions included in Data Protection Act

GID is entitled to share personal data and owners' consent is not required in the following cases:

- It is according to legislation or regulations;
- The data are in public access sources;
- Personal data has been subject to a prior dissociation procedure;
- The sharing has the purpose of fulfilling obligations derived from a legal relationship between the owner and the person in charge;
- There is an emergency that could potentially harm to owner on his person or on his property and,
- The sharing is required by competent authority.

Data use limitations

The owner's personal data provided through legal and reliable media or collected the website, shall be treated as confidential.

The personal data provided by any media, even verbal, shall be used and disclosed in accordance with this Notice of Privacy.

GID will establish the necessary and reasonable processes and measures to cancel the files of the personal data owners, when such personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes referred in this Notice and/or when GID is no longer legally bound to save them and/or when it is requested by the Owner.

GID will not transfer and/or disclose the personal data provided in terms of this privacy notice, except when, according the applicable legislation, it is necessary to attend the requirements from competent administrative or judicial authorities.

Access, Rectification, Cancellation and Opposition Rights (ARCO Rights)

The owner has the right to access provided personal data, its treatment details, to rectificate if inaccuracy or incompleteness, to cancel them or to oppose when they consider the personal data are not necessary for the purposes contained or consented in this Privacy Notice, or such personal data are used for purposes not consented and finally, to oppose the processing of such data for specific and clearly expressed purposes.

The request made by the personal data owner must contain at least the next information:

- Name of the personal data owner;
- Address or email for follow-up;
- Documents of identity. In case of being a legal representative, the public deed the faculties are granted;
- Clear and precise description of the sensitive personal data related to the request;
- Any additional information that facilitates the location of the personal data, as well as any information that in accordance with the legislation and the privacy notice is required to follow up on the request.

The term to answer your request will be a maximum of twenty working days from the reception date of your request for access, rectification, cancellation or opposition. (Note: According to Article 3 in section VII of the Data Protection Act, the terms in days shall be deemed as working days).

The Transparency, Information Access and Personal Data Protection National Institute (INAI)

The INAI is the autonomous constitutional institute that guarantees the compliance of the fundamental rights to access public information and protection of personal data.

Data transfer

Your personal data will not be transmitted to third parties without your consent, with the exception of the affiliated companies and/or subsidiaries of GID, in accordance with article 37 of the Data Protection Act, including the other exceptions provided for in said legal system.

Modifications to this privacy notice

GID reserves the right to make, at any time, changes or updates to this privacy notice, derived from new legal requirements. Such changes will be made available through some or all of the following media: visible advertisements in our establishments, our website, email sent to personal data owner, publications in national circulation newspapers, magazines, posters, sound recordings or personally through our personal in our facilities.

Internet Information

At the time you access our website, we receive information regarding your cookies¹ and web beacons².

Sensitive personal information

We inform you that GID shall not collect sensitive personal data.

Video surveillance and photography

Any person who enters the GID facilities, its subsidiary and related companies, may be videotaped by our security cameras, and may also be photographed. The images captured by the cameras of the CCTV system will be used for safety of our personnel, facilities and the persons who visit us.

The video recordings and photographs are stored for 45 to 60 days.

¹ Cookies. These are the text files that are automatically downloaded and stored on the hard disk of the user's computer when browsing a specific web page, which allows certain data to be stored by the Internet server, among them, pages Preferred viewing on the internet.

² Web beacons. Images inserted in pages or Internet portals as well as in emails and that among others can store information about the user's IP address, interaction time on websites, among others.
